

BYLAND ABBEY & MOUNT SNEVER OBSERVATORY



Byland Abbey and Mount Snever Observatory is a 3.5 mile out and back trail located near Coxwold that features a river and is rated as moderate.

Byland Abbey is a ruined abbey and a small village in the Ryedale district. Impressive remains can still be seen, in the care of English Heritage, including the lower half of a huge rose window which was the inspiration for the same window at York Minster.
