

RIEVAULX ABBEY



A walk from Rievaulx Abbey, over Rievaulx Abbey through Spring Wood to Old Byland and back.

Rievaulx Abbey is a Cistercian abbey in Rievaulx, situated near Helmsley in the North York Moors National Park. It was one of the great abbeys in England until it was seized under Henry VIII of England in 1538 during the dissolution of the monasteries. The striking ruins of its main buildings are a tourist attraction, owned and maintained by English Heritage.
